The members of the IQAC were informed that Faculty is working for BTTC students across different programs and getting them ready for CTET exams	In the academic year 2024–2025, 40 students successfully earned certificates through NPTEL, 8 students through SWAYAM, 15 students through the HSNC Kathak Course, 47 students through the Models of Teaching , and 2 students received certifications in other courses. 11 students have successfully cleared CTET in the Batch 2024 - 2025 and 2 students in the current S. Y. batch 2024 - 2026. This year Faculty has taken the Initiative for the UGC NET EXAM Preparation and 41 students has enrolled for the same

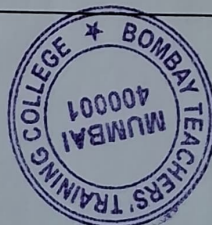
